Price Guide for Basic Pantograph (all over pattern) work and meander using the HandiQuilter ProStitcher.

Quilting is priced by the square inch, and the prices below are for common quilt sizes to be used as a ballpark figure. Your individual price will be calculated based on the actual dimensions of your quilt top. Quilting rates start at \$0.015 per square inch for basic pantograph and meander work.

Crib / Wall (45 x 60)	\$40.50	Double / Full (81 x 96)	\$116.64
Lap (45 x 90)	\$60.75	Queen (90 x 108)	\$145.80
Sofa (60 x 108)	\$97.20	King Size #1 (108 x 108)	\$174.96
Twin (72 x 90)	\$97.20	King Size #2 (120 x 120)	\$216.00

You may supply the batting and/or backing or may purchase it from me. If you provide the back or batting, please make sure it's at least 4" larger than your quilt top, all the way around. Don't worry about pre-layering your quilt -- I'll take care of that part. I use Warm & White and Warm & Natural batting.

Type of Quilting	Cost Per Square Inch
Basic Overall Pattern over the entire quilt surface (includes border)	\$ 0.12 to 0.17
More intricate / decorative pattern over the entire quilt surface (includes border)	\$ 0.16 to 0.23
Overall Pattern with different quilting on the borders (one pattern quilted over entire quilt surface with a different pattern / design on each border)	\$ 0.18 to 0.22
Custom Quilting (This type of quilting includes a wide variety of different designs, either freehand or stencils)	\$ 0.20 to 0.30

Other Charges	Cost
Turning Quilt (I often quilt borders without turning the quilt, however sometimes turning is necessary to create a continuous flow)	\$ 10.00
Thread (I normally use Superior and Signature brand one-color thread or Variegated thread; your choice)	\$ 2.00 - \$16.00
Piece Backing (if I have to piece together your backing)	\$10.00 first seam; \$2.50 each additional seam
Custom Quilting (This type of quilting includes a wide variety of different designs, either freehand or stencils)	\$ 0.20 to 0.30

(Requirements & Helpful Hints on back)

Requirements & Helpful Hints

1. Make sure your backing and batting are at least 4" bigger on all sides than your top.
2. Make sure your seams are well pressed. Top and back should lie flat.
3. The quilt top and backing fabric should be free of loose threads, both front and back, that can cause snags or uneven stitching.

One more thing...please don't expect me to "quilt out" mistakes. Hahaha...
